OVERVIEW

The business world of the 21st century has become considerably more competitive, intense and unpredictable, making the jobs and the lives of today's senior executives extremely challenging.

LE journey not only adds knowledge, but also increases the practical skills of management. LEARNING GOALS

The LE is a deep dive on effectively role modeling the changes in mindsets and behaviors leaders expect by first going through a personal transformation and by applying new practices in the context of participants' specific leadership challenges. Specifically, successful participants will walk away with:

- Understanding yourself: Greater self-awareness and ability to shift their own mindsets & behaviors, your leadership behaviour and its roots, your cognitive and emotional inner programming, your real drivers
- Personal vision and a concrete action plan to role model new behaviors
- Looking forward – what kind of leader do you want to become and what are you hoping to obtain from the next phase of your professional and personal lives?
- Influencing others: Improving the individual and collective performance of your team, managing conflict
- Understanding, diagnosing and managing stress in organisations
- Recognising and managing your own emotions and the role of emotions in the inter-personal context
- Functioning of the mind and the mind-body connection
- Meaningful relationships with leaders facing similar challenges
- Achieving strategic clarity
- Leading and implementing change
- Developing a high-performance organisational culture
